Stocks End With Loss

NEW YORK (AP) — Selling pressure slightly outbalanced buying power in a turbulent pre-Christmas session Friday and the stock market ended with a loss.

Volume was 7.47 million shares compared with 8.57 million Thursday.

The Dow Jones industrial average declined 2.57 to 799.10, dipping once more below the 800 line which has been crossed and recrossed several times in the last several weeks of consolidation.

Wilson Co. was the most active stock, off 3/4 at 61 on 276,000 shares, of which 222,500 came in a single block. Profits were taken on its rise of 6 1/2 Thursday when it spurred on news that Ling-Temco-Vought had made a tender at \$62.50 a share for 750,000 shares of the stock. E-T-V rose 1 1/2.

Lion, Intended as Gift, Mauls Two
CENTERVILLE, Ill. (AP) — Lucky, a lion cub intended as a Christmas gift, was killed by gunfire Friday night after losing his composure at a tavern and mauling his owner and the tavern owner.

Historians had reported massacres of Jews by Crusaders in Germany and one place in northern France, Rouen.

The newly-translated document shows the first known evidence of the Provencal army before it reached Italy, the translator said.

Only Source
The report on the document, by Norman Golb, associate professor of medieval Jewish studies at the University of Chicago, has been published in proceedings of the American Academy for Jewish Research.

Golb's article said the Hebrew document appears to be the only documentary source in any language pertaining to the activities of the Provencal crusaders before their arrival in Dalmatia.

The document, a damaged parchment, is part of a collection emanating from the Cairo genizah (storage room). The collection is now in the Cambridge university library in England.

Woman's Letter
Golb describes the document as an unidentified woman's letter of introduction to the Jewish community of Cairo after Crusaders killed her husband and kidnapped her two children.

The woman was described only as a convert to Judaism, the daughter of a wealthy and prominent Christian family, who had fled to a large Jewish community in Narbonne, France, and there met and married a Jew.

The document implies Mon-Jew, too, had a sizable Jewish group, since it identifies itself by Golb:

The woman and her husband, as coming from "the congregation of Jews."

When the Pope preached his message and they began to make preparations for the journey, they began asking one another, "Why should we go to fight the Saracens in the East when here among us are the greatest enemies of the Lord?"

Closely Figured
The time element? It works out pretty closely to tie in with the time of the First Crusade.

The letter mentions that the husband, David, was a relative of Rabbi Todros, leader of the Narbonne Jews. The letter indicates Todros' death with a statement about him, adding, "his memory be for a blessing."

Todros died in the last quarter of the 11th century, after which his son became head of the Narbonne community. Todros' son died about 1130.

Golb writes that if the document had been written after 1130, it would have called for a blessing on the memory of Todros' son.

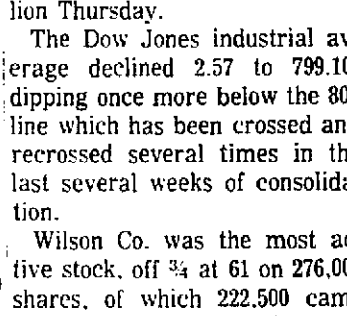
Was there a First Crusade in that area?

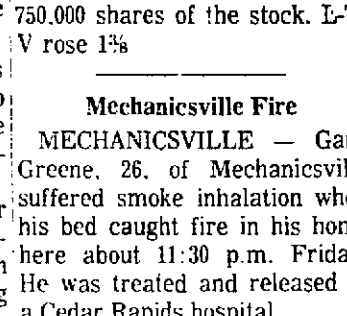
But because of its size, it did not travel as a unit since this would have created a supply problem.
