## Look for Pontiac in Set Talks on Iowa City Murder

IOWA CITY—Iowa City police announced Wednesday that they may have a new clue into the grocery store robbery-murder of Ronald Spt. Don Strand said that authorities are now looking for a white over black, 1958 Pontiac sedan that was seen speeding away from the scene shortly after the shooting.

Strand said the clue came from a construction worker who said he was involved in an accident at Sheridan and Seventh avenue, just five blocks from the holdup. The construction worker reported to police that the pickup he was driving and the Pontiac backed into each other and that the Pontiac sped off. It was reportedly driven by an 18 to 19-year-old male who was accompanied by a female companion of approximately the same age.

An earlier lead on a green Chevrolet seen in the area at the time of the shooting turned out to be one driven by a customer at the Lipsius store. Strand said anyone having information about the black and white, 4-door Pontiac should contact police. He said there may be damage to the left-front fender of the car and possible green paint markings from the pickup truck.

The victim of the shooting and attempted robbery, 30-year-old Ronald Lipsius, was shot three times by a female subject who attempted to holdup his store.
