## World Gospel Missionaries to speak at Lovilia UMC

The Rev. Dean and Leta  
Strong, missionaries to Kenya  
with World Gospel Mission, will  
speak at Lovilia United  
Methodist Church in Lovilia at  
7:30 p.m. July 18. A family night  
supper will be at 6:30. The public  
is invited.

When the Strongs first went to  
Kenya in 1958, they began work-  
ing with the churches in rural  
areas. Upon returning for a  
second term four years later,  
Strong became principal of the  
Kenya Highlands Bible College  
and, eventually, director of  
WGM's Kenya field.

He also had frequent oppor-  
tunities to preach in various  
church meetings and for  
evangelism excursions into un-  
reached areas.

Mrs. Strong devoted many  
hours to the preparation of  
tracts, booklets and Sunday  
school and vacation Bible school  
materials.

In 1973, however, the Strongs  
returned to the United States  
while the four oldest of their five  
children were pursuing their  
college educations. For four  
years, Strong was on the faculty  
of Vennard College in Oskaloosa  
in the missions department,  
while Mrs. Strong worked in a  
day care center operated by the  
college.

In 1979, the Strongs and  
daughter Karen went back to  
Kenya, where they were  
engaged in pastoral teaching  
and evangelism. They traveled  
to conduct four-day meetings in  
each of the approximately 50  
districts of Africa Gospel  
Church, including classes for
