MAQUOKETA, Iowa - The file on Maquoketa's only unsolved murder is inactive, but the case remains open. Police Chief Bob Andersen hopes a death-bed confession will someday solve the mystery.

Andersen was the investigating officer for the Maquoketa police force in 1975, under Chief Mark Brooks. On Feb. 25, a cold, snowy night Andersen recalls, he and Brooks were called to the Fifth Street residence of Hulda Fischer. There they found a grisly sight - the 84-year-old woman
