

Believe Archer man's death drug related

 A 20-year-old Archer man whose badly decomposed body was found behind a corn crib on a vacant farm 2 1/2 miles southeast of Maxwell Tuesday morning apparently died of a slashed throat, Story County authorities said.
 The slaying victim was identified as Terry Lee Vanden Hull.
 Story County Sheriff John Stark said: "I believe the death was drug related." Vanden Hull

was released from the drug treatment unit at the State Mental Health Institute at Cherokee on Jan. 31, authorities said.
 The body was found between 8:30 a.m. and 9 a.m. Thursday by three Maxwell area men on a farm owned by Colleen Shaffer. No one lives at the farm, authorities said.
 John Oxley of Maxwell, who works the farm, said he and two other men, Clyde Martin and Laverne Elding, were moving machinery from a shed at

the farm when they discovered the body hidden in a grassy area behind the corn crib.
 Authorities said that Vanden Hull had been staying with friends in the Maxwell and Collins area but had not been seen since mid-to-late February.
 "We know he was in Collins in the latter part of February," Sheriff Stark said.
 Craig Beek, BCI director, said four agents were assigned to the case. Beek and Sheriff Stark said interviews with several persons would be conducted and leads are being followed.
 O'Brien County Sheriff's deputies said Vanden Hull was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jake Vanden Hull of Archer.

Viet relief set by Ames group

 AMES, IA. — A group of Vietnamese and Americans in the Ames community have set up a Vietnam-Relief Committee to organize fund-raising activities.
 A fund drive, which started Wednesday, will continue until Apr. 27 with a fund-raising dinner, art display and auction of Vietnamese handicrafts that day.
 Tickets will be on sale at the Memorial Union on the Iowa State University campus starting Monday. Proceeds will be sent to the International Red Cross to be used in assisting war victims in Vietnam.

SUIT NAMES SUPERVISORS

Attorney James Brick of Des Moines filed a complaint with the State Public Employment Relations Board Thursday, charging the Polk County Board of Supervisors with engaging in unfair labor practices.
 Brick is representing Local 246 of the Painters and Allied Trades, which is vying with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) to represent Polk County employees in labor negotiations.
 Also Named
 The petition also names Supervisors Tom Whitney, Rich-

ard Brannan and Jack Bishop and charges that they met with AFSCME representatives illegally to discuss a proposed contract between AFSCME and the county.
 The supervisors voted Tuesday to sign the AFSCME-negotiated contract, which will run through June 1976.
 Brick contends, however, that county employees have never been given the opportunity to vote on which of the two unions they want to represent them.
 Cites "Disregard"
 "The board simply went ahead and negotiated (with AFSCME). This is the most contemptuous disregard of Iowa law I've ever seen," said Brick.
 Peter Pashler, executive director of the Public Employment Relations Board, said he will have 10 days to answer the complaint before a hearing will be set on the matter.
 Pashler said both the painters' union and AFSCME have filed petitions asking permission to represent county employees.
