



Fear bad vaccine spreads hog cholera

PORTSMOUTH, R.I. (AP) - Outlawed hog cholera vaccine might have touched off the recent outbreak of the disease in Massachusetts and Rhode Island, a U.S. Agriculture Department spokeswoman said Thursday.

"Washington has evidence the vaccine has been sold up here," said Kathy Ellis. "And we have evidence it's been used.'

Ellis also said the vaccine, banned in 1969 because the USDA felt it was spreading the disease, could threaten hogs throughout the country if it were in wide use in New England.
