The trip took him to Germany, Belgium, France, Holland, England, Scotland, Ireland and Russia.

Drehner reported that he had talked to some Germans, prisoners of the allies, who had said they were sorry to hear that Roosevelt had died. He was their only chance for the rehabilitation of Germany, they had said.

On a former trip his convoy had got 9 subs and assisted in the sinking of the Von Tirpitz along the Norwegian coast.
